This center activity or game is designed to give your kiddos a chance to practice patterns, matching and sequencing. I made this game after I found some silk butterflies (in the floral section at Dollar Tree - \$1 for about 15). Print out and laminate the cards and cut them into strips if you want. If you purchase the butterflies, you can have the children put the color-coordinated butterflies on the matching square. If you don't want to buy them, just print out two copies and cut one set apart, then have the children match the single butterfly to a matching place on the strip. You can also have the child extend the pattern using the butterflies or cards.
