21st Century Skills Definition:

A series of higher-order skills identified as being required for success in 21st Century society and workplaces.

These skills have been identified by professional educators, business leaders, academics, and governmental agencies as being crucial for students to master in preparation for success in a rapidly changing, digital society.

21st Century skills differ from traditional academic skills in that they are not primarily content knowledge-based.
